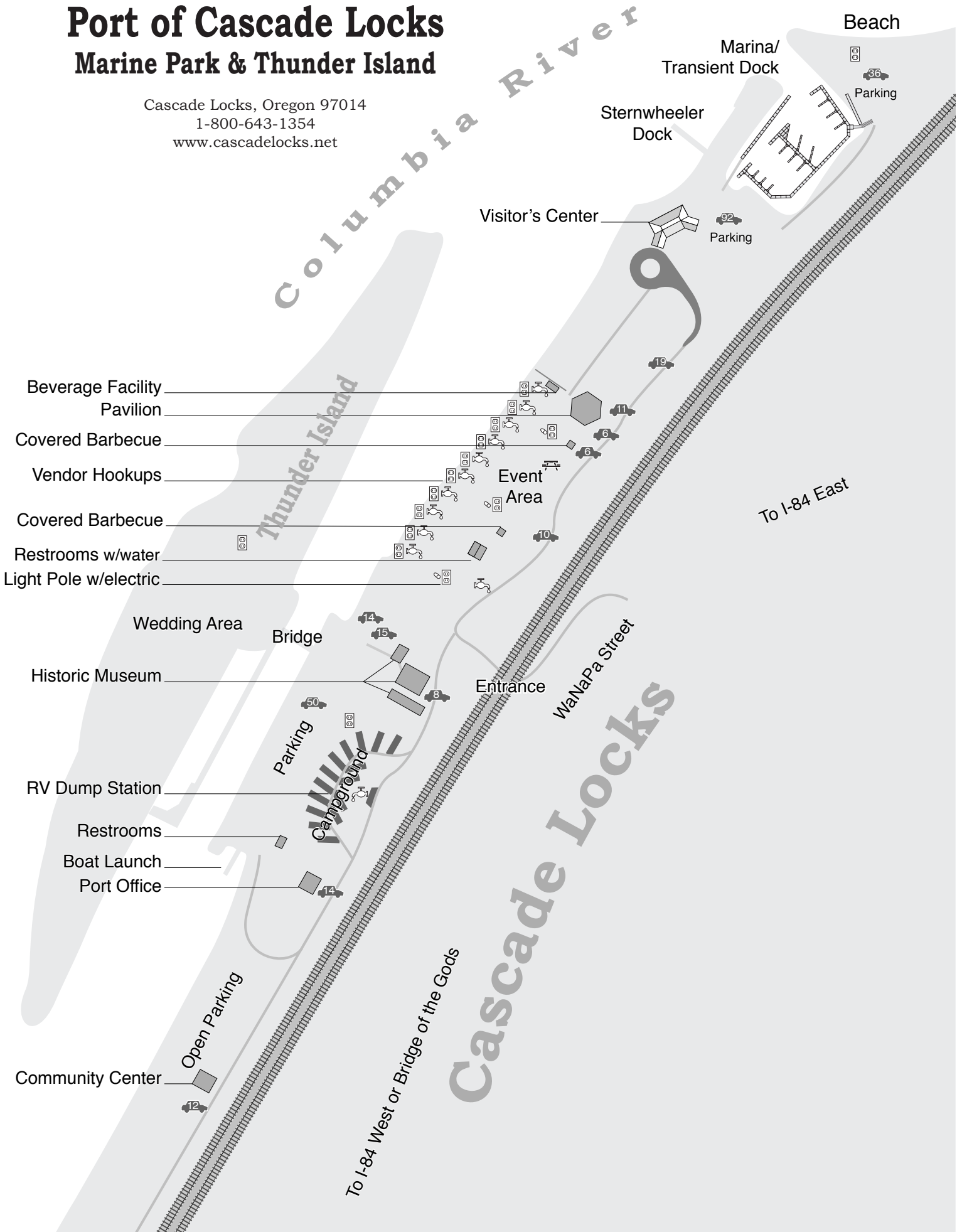

## Port Facilities and Amenities

### Event Area

Ideal for large events requiring open space and access to water / electrical facilities and sheltered areas. See specifics below.

#### 1. Event Area

- Hook-ups: 110 Electrical (10), 40' apart, Light poles with 110 (3) 125' apart
- Water: 10
- Total area: 46,800 square feet. 520'x90'
- Parking: 52 spaces in immediate area, total of 274 spaces in Marine Park

#### 2. Pavilion

- Size: 1,600 sq. ft.
- Dimensions: 40x40 (octagon)
- Hook-ups: 110 electrical
- Water: outside hook-up
- Completely enclosed with glass windows and doors, paved floor
- Restrooms
- Sound system

#### 3. Tents

- Size: 10x10, 10x20
- Cost: Community members: \$100 for 2 hours, \$25 for each additional hour not to exceed 4 hours
- Cost: Non-community members: \$300 for 2 hours, \$75 for each additional hour

#### 4. Tables

- 60 picnic tables (there is a charge for moving)

#### 5. Chairs

- Approximately 200

#### 6. Covered BBQ

- 4 available
- Hook-up: 110 electrical

#### 7. Cook Shack / Beverage Facility

- 2 available
- \$25 charge for an all day rental

### Indoor Facilities

The Visitor's Center and Community Center are ideal for groups requiring fully enclosed facilities with amenities.

#### 8. Visitor's Center ([www.sternwheeler.com](http://www.sternwheeler.com))

- Space: 1,418 sq. ft.
- Outside with covered seating area with a view of the Columbia River
- Parking: 92 spaces
- Cafe

#### 9. Community Center

- Square footage: 986 sq. ft. of usable space
- Cost: Community members: \$25 for meeting room only, \$35 for the meeting room and kitchen. Additional \$5 per hour over 4 hours.
- Cost: Non-community members: \$50 for meeting room only, \$75 for the meeting room and kitchen. Additional \$5 per hour over 4 hours
- Tables and Chairs: Seats 40 total
- Kitchen set-up: Full kitchen inside Community Center
- Restroom: one inside Community Center
- Handicap accessible
- Parking: 12 spaces
- \$50 refundable deposit

### Marine Facilities

The Marine Park offers full services for boaters including moorage, launching and a beach for sailing and play.

#### 10. Marina / Transit Dock

- Number of slips: 36
- Cost to moor: Transient moorage with dump station for up to 72 hours is FREE
- Monthly/annual cost to moor: Boats 30 feet and under \$83 monthly, \$650 annually. Boats over 30 feet \$2.85/ft.month, \$1.57/ft/month/year

- Specifics: Entrance is 7-10 feet deep, 20 feet wide. Marina depth is 12-15 feet.
- Services: Utility fee, key fee, sewage dump
- Parking: 36 spaces

#### 11. Boat Launch

- Day use docking: none (use Marina)
- Length of dock: 112 feet
- Depth/width of launch: two launches, depth 12-15 feet / width 22 feet
- Restrooms: in parking lot
- Parking: 50 spaces

#### 12. Beach

- Length: 325
- Uses: sailing, swimming, kiteboarding, windsurfing, protected cove
- Parking: 36 spaces

### Outdoor Areas

Thunder Island is a beautiful natural area reserved for weddings and low impact outdoor gatherings. With three acres of land available, Thunder Island can accommodate large groups.

#### 13. Thunder Island

- Acreage: 3 acres
- Length: 2,000 feet
- Width: 300 feet
- Water: irrigation only
- Sewer: none
- Electrical: one box
- Bridge details: 10 feet wide with a 10,000 lb. weight capacity

### Camping

#### 14. Campground

- Cost: \$25/night with hook-ups, \$15/night without hook-ups
- Number of spaces: 16
- For use for both tents and RV's
- Dumpsite is located next to the pavilion
- Showers are located at the Visitor's Center
- 12 foot height restriction at the entrance to the park

- Height: 12 feet
- Width: 20 feet

#### 16. Parking

- Marina / Beach: 36
- Boat Launch: 50
- Event Area: 81
- Museum: 8
- Community Center: 12
- Visitor's Center: 92
- Port Office: 14
- Handicap: 10
- Overflow parking available in open areas: 100
- Total: 393
- Large vehicle / trailer parking at boat launch
- Additional parking along WaNaPa Street
